

The Sprout Social Skills Program is for kids ages 6 and up with Autism Spectrum Disorder, High Functioning Autism, PDD-NOS, Asperger Syndrome, ADHD, Nonverbal Learning Disorder, or other social learning difficulties. Groups match 3-4 kids by age and social development level. Call to discuss eligibility.

What

Students will learn concepts using vocabulary and ideas from the Social Thinking® framework, created by Michelle Garcia Winner. Sessions include teaching time, games, group play/projects, as well as discussion and conversation. Topics include:

- Being part of a group
- Using our eyes to observe and think about others
- Observing and interpreting social expectations
- Gauging the size of the problem and choosing an appropriate reaction

When

The program runs for 4 to 8 weeks at various times throughout the year. Sessions are one hour in length, including time for parent education.
